The Father Hoefler Challenge

When I first became the Director of Development for Blessed Sacrament School, I knew that there were two especially pressing issues that needed to be addressed. The first was to increase communication, especially to try and locate our alumni, a task that continues today. As a direct link to our history and tradition at Blessed Sacrament school, the alumni are an important part of our community. We want to share the good news about our school today, and enjoy hearing about the life and times of our students from the past.

The second goal I wanted to accomplish was to implement an Annual Fund effort. An Annual Fund is an ongoing, fundraising program that supports our school's operating budget. I knew what needed to be done, but was a little nervous about just how much we would be able to raise, especially in a first year.

On the evening of our first Annual Fund Reception in July of 2007, Father Hoefler handed me a personal check for \$1,000.00 to get the Fund off to "a good start." He told me that he could hardly ask others to make a gift if he didn't give as well. Since that time, donations of \$1,000 or more to the Annual Fund in a given fiscal year are referred to as Father Hoefler Challenge gifts.

During the 2007-2008 fiscal year, 32 families took the "Father Hoefler Challenge" in honor of our pastor's commitment and dedication to Blessed Sacrament School. We thank Father Hoefler and the donors listed on the left.

Like No Other Trip... The Challenger Space Station

Two class trips, Fermi lab, St. Louis Zoo, innumerable sporting events and science fair competition all the way to Champaign. Since sending kids through Blessed Sacrament for the past decade-plus I have had many opportunities to accompany my little ones to many events. None were quite like the trip I took last month.

It all started at 7:30 that morning; we arrived at Bloomington around 9:00. I interviewed Nicolas to explain the rest.

S: What did we do in Bloomington?

N: We went into space and sent off a probe to get details about a comet.

S: How did you do that?

N: Half the class stayed on the ground to run mission control. The other half went into space to a space station. We all broke off into groups to work on our separate stations. Some of the stations were navigation, medical, life support, communication, probe and data. Everyone communicated with mission control by voice and by written data sent by the data team to find out how to complete their jobs. We had written directions and cards to complete experiments and tasks to make sure we completed the mission.

S: What was your team and what was your responsibility?

N: I was on the life support team. I had to make sure the oxygen level was correct and the humidity had to be at the right level or else static electricity could mess up the space station machinery. Later I had to tell my partner what was wrong with the oxygen and he had to fix it. An emergency light and horn came on to tell me the static electricity was too high.

S: What did you do to help other teams?

N: The medical team spun us in a chair to test to see if we get sick on spinning rides. They put a blindfold and earmuffs on us and spun us to see if we could tell them which direction, by pointing with our thumbs we were spinning in the chair. We also wore spectrum analysis goggles to determine what gases were present in a comet we were trying to identify.

S: Was this like a "rocket ship" made from a big cardboard box in your garage?

N: No, it had a bunch of working equipment on it for all the stations. It looked like a real space ship; full of details, tools, lights, controls and 'contraptions'.

S: Tell me how you got to the space station?

N: We went on a space ship or space shuttle. It actually seemed and felt like you were in a space ship. It really actually shook and the buttons and lights on the dashboard looked real.

S: What did the chaperones do?

N: Nothing

This was one of the best field trips I have ever been on with my 4 children at BSS. The whole facility is very well run, clean and the staff was very professional. The Challenger Space Station was one of the most rewarding and memorable trips on which I have accompanied the students. It was very realistic and offered the kids a chance to use their class studies in a practical application. The hands-on interactive setting also offered real-life problem solving. It was so fun to watch the students work together and work out problems as they arose. Another "well done" to the faculty and staff at the school, and to the generous benefactors who made this trip possible. This trip also included a visit to the ISU planetarium and the museum at the airport. We ate Avanti's and best of all as a chaperone, I did nothing!
