STEWARDSHIP COMMITMENT & PARENT AGREEMENT

"Since parents have conferred life on their children, they have a most solemn obligation to educate their offspring. Hence, parents must be acknowledged as the first and foremost educators of their children." Declaration on Christian Education, Vatican II.

I, as parent, believe that I have the primary responsibility in the education of my child(ren). I set the attitudes and values which give real meaning to Christian education in the school. I wish to work in partnership with Blessed Sacrament School to educate my child(ren). I understand my responsibility as parent of (a) Blessed Sacrament child(ren) by agreeing to each of the following:

- 1) That my child(ren) and I are registered members of Blessed Sacrament Parish;
- 2) As the first teacher of my children in ways of our faith, I pledge to share my faith with my child(ren) at home, in prayer and in conversation, and bring my child(ren) to Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation during the entire calendar year so that they may join the whole church in worshipping God and receiving Christ's sacraments;
- 3) That I will be a steward of the parish by volunteering my time and talents;
- 4) That I will support the parish by regular verifiable contributions in the Sunday collection;
- 5) That I will pay tuition, according to my tuition agreement;
- 5) That I will attend all parental sessions for the sacramental preparation of my child(ren);
- 6) That I will assist the faculty by offering my cooperation and support;
- 7) That I will have my child(ren) show respect for and cooperate with the faculty at all times;
- 8) That I will attend all scheduled Parent-Teacher Conferences to be active in my child(ren)'s education;
- 9) That I will complete 20 hours of service to the school or parish, or pay \$20 per hour; and
- 10) I request participation in the Textbook Loan Program in accordance with Public Act 79-961 of 1975, when it is funded by the state. This law provides funds that help supplement Blessed Sacrament School's textbook fund.

I, as a parent, understand that the school will, in turn, work with me toward an acceptable solution of any problems that may arise during the year.

At the discretion of the school administrator and pastor, violation by the parent of any of the agreed to obligations set forth above may result in the dismissal of the child or children from Blessed Sacrament School.
