

BLESSED SACRAMENT PARISH SCHOOL
2010-2011 FINANCIAL PROCEDURES & GUIDELINES for GRADES K-8

Families must be current with tuition payments for the current calendar year to be eligible to register for the next school year.

TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE

Registration Fees: \$75.00 per student (non-refundable) This fee MUST accompany school registration forms for the student(s) registration to be complete.

Kindergarten Snack Fee: \$30.00 per kindergarten student

Tuition - Grades K-8:

1 child	\$ 3,580.00
2 children	5,160.00
3 or more children	6,680.00
Non-parish	5,100.00 per student

Tuition includes the costs associated with class field trips, the price of one yearbook per child, Holy Childhood membership dues, classroom party fees, and one directory per family. We have included these costs in our tuition structure so that you will no longer have to write numerous checks throughout the school year for these events.

Tuition does not include sports fees, mission donations, milk or juice, school supplies, fundraisers, and graduation fees.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

Option 1 – One payment

Full payment is due on Fee Night in August.

Option 2 – Two payments

50% of the tuition is due on Fee Night in August.

The remaining 50% will be due December 1, 2010.

If unforeseen financial problems should occur that prevent a family from making the 2nd payment on time, the balance will be converted to monthly payments with the FACTS Automatic Monthly Payment Plan (see below).

Option 3 – Ten monthly payments

Families selecting this option are required to complete the FACTS Automatic Tuition Agreement. (A paper application will be sent home, if requested on your registration form, after registration is processed. You may also apply online following the link on our school website.) Monthly payments are deducted from your checking or savings account. The first payment is deducted in August 2010, with monthly payments through May 2011. A processing fee of \$43.00 will be assessed from FACTS Management Company.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Those who feel they are unable to meet the financial commitment and meet the eligibility requirements outlined in the enclosed Tuition Assistance Program form should complete an application by the end of May.
