Eligibility

The Knights of Columbus Free Throw Championship is open to all boys and girls, ages 10 – 14. Age eligibility is determined by the age of the contestant as of January 1, 2012. Proof of age is required. The Illinois Elementary School Association (IESA) has approved student-athletes in their member schools to participate in this event. High school age student-athletes should be advised to check with the Illinois High School Association (IHSA) or their school athletic director regarding possible eligibility conflicts

Entries

Participants are encouraged to complete and the attached entry form, but may register on the day of the council competition. They must bring their proof of age in order to advance to the District Level. Each participant may compete in ONLY ONE COUNCIL COMPETITION. Winners will progress to district, regional and state competition. International champions are chosen on the basis of state-level results.

Scoring

At the council level, each participant will be provided 3 warm-up tosses followed by 15 consecutive free throws.

At the district, regional and state level, each participant will be provided 3 warm-up tosses followed by 25 consecutive free throws.

Tie breakers will consist of a subsequent round of five free throws with no warm-up tosses. This will be repeated until a winner is determined.

Basketballs will be provided and the council winner in each division will receive an official K of C Free Throw Championship ball.
