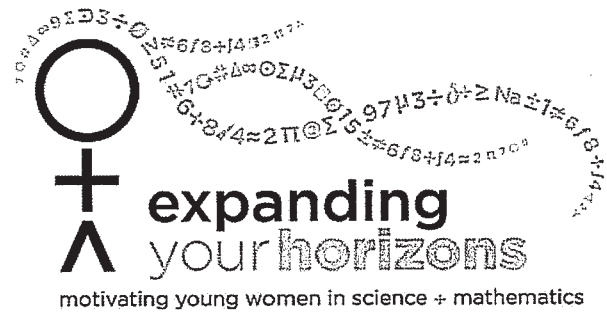
A hands-on career conference for girls in 6th, 7th and 8th grade
